



# Have your say on active travel and the future of transport near you

**Cambridgeshire County Council has developed three transport strategies, and we want to know your thoughts.**

Two district-based transport strategies for Fenland and Huntingdonshire set the detailed transport vision for the districts.

The Active Travel Strategy for Cambridgeshire sets the detailed approach for improvements to active travel across the county.

The district-based transport strategies have been developed to tackle the existing transport problems and address future growth in the districts and support the achievement of carbon net zero in Cambridgeshire by 2045.

They provide the holistic approach to how people will be able to travel where they live and work, of which active travel provides an important option, particularly for those who are not able to travel by car. The Active Travel Strategy for Cambridgeshire aims to make active travel the 'go-to' option for local journeys.

All strategies come under the Local Transport and Connectivity Plan, being developed by Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Combined Authority and consulted on this summer.
